From a gentleman who recently came out from Nome the BEE-NUGGET learns that Leslie Crim, a former well-known citizen of Lewis county, has lined up to make a fortune up north. According to the statement of the gentleman, Mr. Crim has recently sold seven tin mining properties for \$140,000. He has three other particularly good claims for which he has been offered \$100,000, but which he is holding. Mr. Crim has other valuable properties besides these. The tin mines are about five miles from the ocean and something like eighty miles up the coast north of Nome. Our informant states that Leslie Crim is in a fair way to come out from the north within two years worth a million dollars or more.
